Vineyard

Cancilla Vineyard, which makes up the bulk of the Willamette Valley blend, lies in the northern end of the Willamette Valley in the foothills of the Coast Range. This vineyard is a relatively cooler site allowing for full development of flavors while keeping alcohol moderate and preserving acidity. Followed by Bjornson Vineyard and this year, the introduction of Croft Vineyard. Like Cancilla Vineyard, Croft Vineyard is located in the foothills of the Coast Range, although about 50 miles south of Cancilla Vineyard. Certified organic and dry-farmed, Croft is a great addition to the blend. 1025 cases produced
